What is the voltage in Cape Verde?

Just like the rest of Europe,the voltage in Cape Verde is 230 voltsand the frequency is 50 Hz. Cape Verde has standardized on type F sockets and plugs. Type C and type E plugs can also be used thanks to their compatibility with type F sockets.

Do I need a power adapter in Cape Verde?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications,you will not need a power adapter. However,if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cape Verde,you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer. The standard voltage in Cape Verde is 230 V,and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.

What type of plug does Cape Verde use?

In Cape Verde,types C and Fare the official standards. As a former colony of Portugal,Cape Verde has standardized on the German plug and socket system. What is the mains voltage in Cape Verde? What electrical sockets are used in Cape Verde?

The electrical sockets used in Cape Verde are type C and type F. These are 2 variants of the same socket - one grounded (with an earth pin) and the other ungrounded. You will therefore need a UK 3 pin to type C/F adaptor in order to plug in your appliances. The mains voltage in Cape Verde is 230 V which is compatible with all UK appliances.

Are plug sockets allowed in Cape Verde?

Typically,type C plug sockets are not allowedto be installed in Cape Verde: these outlets are not earthed and are therefore considered dangerous. Only type F power points are permitted because they are grounded and therefore significantly safer.

Do Cape Verde plugs convert voltage or frequency?

It is important to note that it does notconvert the voltage or frequency. For Cape Verde there are two associated plug types,C and F. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and type F is the plug which has two round pins with two earth clips on the side. Cape Verde operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.
